## WORLD FLIGHT EXPEDITION APPLICATION

Please print this application form, complete and sign it, then return to us by surface mail. It is important that you complete all of the information so that we can serve you best.

We take your application to join a World Flyers World Flight Expedition seriously. Our application process will require some extra time and paperwork from you, but this helps us do a better job screening our participants and ensuring that our flight team members meet the requirements to fly any of our flight expedition, including our around the world flight. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have questions regarding our application procedures.

### APPLICATION PROCEDURES

#### **Initial steps:**

Carefully read, execute and submit the following **forms 1, 2, 3, 4** and supporting materials in order to apply for and reserve your position as a flight team member:

**Form 1:** General Terms and Conditions.

**Form 2:** Participant Information.

**Form 3:** Participant Medical Information.

**Form 4:** Acknowledgement of Risk and Contract, Waiver, Release and Indemnification.

**If you are MARRIED, your spouse's signature is \*\*\*REQUIRED\*\*\* on Form 4.**

Include a check for your application fee payable to World Flyers Inc. All payments are to be in US dollars. If you are applying for program admission within 45 days of a flight program's start date, all fees for the program are due and payable.

For this flight expedition, applicants must include a good quality photocopy of the first two pages of your passport showing the full legal name, date of birth, passport number and citizenship under which you will be traveling. **Please make sure that your passport is valid for at least 6 months AFTER the trip to avoid visa problems.**

We encourage you to send application materials using FedEx, United Parcel Service or U.S. Postal Service Express Mail.

You will be notified by email upon our receipt of your completed application materials and formal acceptance for the program. Your position is not confirmed until all properly executed forms and application fees have been received and reviewed in the World Flyers office in Buena Vista, Colorado. World Flyers will send you additional program materials, instructions and updates via email as needed.

## **FORM 1: General Terms and Conditions:**

**World Flyers Inc. reserves the right to deny participation to any individual. Upon acceptance of your Application Package and confirmation by World Flyers, applicants are deemed Flight Team Members (Participants) of the selected Flight Expedition and are subject to all of the following terms and conditions:**

### **RESPONSIBILITIES OF FLIGHT TEAM MEMBERS**

We expect participants to be in good health and current with respect to flight experience. We expect participants to bring proper personal clothing. Participants need to read and understand the materials they have received regarding the program and its objectives, itinerary, travel plans. Participants should contact World Flyers whenever questions arise. Everyone is expected to work together as a flight crew team, to be considerate of every flight crew team member. All members are responsible for: being current with respect to aviation medical certificates, Flight Reviews and flight currencies, preparing clothing, snacks/energy food, visas, insurance, inoculations, flights, acting in a safety-conscious, team-spirited, considerate manner toward all flight crew members and with respect for each country's customs, environment, and people, and conforming to basic standards of personal and group hygiene (to minimize the risk of traveler's diseases, and pollution of the environment). Like it or not, we are guests of the governments of the nations we visit. Participants are not allowed to engage in any acts involving physical nor provocative contact, nor any political discussions nor political actions with the local, associated, nor governing populace.

### **WORLD FLYERS DISCRETION**

World Flyers requires Participants to be prepared physically, technically and psychologically for the selected Flight Expedition, and World Flyers reserves the right to dismiss a Participant from a flight team at any time based on any factors that World Flyers discovers. Participants must supply World Flyers true, complete and accurate information on the Participant Information Form (including the information concerning training and prior flight experience), Participant Medical Information form, and in any other written or oral communications. World Flyers reserves the right to dismiss any Participant at any time if, in the sole judgment of World Flyers, it is in the best interest of that Participant or any other person. World Flyers reserves the right to change, alter or cancel the itinerary as, in World Flyer's sole discretion, World Flyers finds necessary for the proper and safe conduct of the flight program. Participants acknowledge that World Flyers flight program plans are necessarily subject to change based on a number of factors, including but not limited to weather, terrain, changes in costs, and many other factors, and that World Flyers has complete discretion to effect any change of plans to accommodate any of these or other factors, including but not limited to increases in program fees, changes to the program schedule or itinerary, change of instructors or staff, and changes to any means of conveyance, when deemed necessary or advisable, without notice and without allowance of refund and with the liability for any increased program fees, if any, to be borne by each flight team participant.

### **PROGRAM FEES AND PAYMENTS**

Registration for World Flyer's Flight Expeditions requires a minimum \$3,750 application deposit. Final balances are due 45 days before the first scheduled date of the flight program. It is the participant's responsibility to adhere to the fee payment schedule. Participants may not receive additional notice of payment due dates from World Flyers.

The Participant's cancelled checks will serve as the receipt and verification of payments. Late payments may result in cancellation of program reservations and forfeiture of all fees paid.

It must be noted here that our Flight Expeditions are not pre-paid packages. A \$3,750 deposit is required with this application

World Flyers accepts certified funds only. We can accept personal checks within 20 business days before your flight starts. We cannot accept personal checks for payment after 20 business days before your flight date or after your arrival date.

### **CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY**

Cancellations made greater than 90 days before the program date will result in refund of all fees paid less your deposit fee. Cancellations made within 90 days of the program date will result in forfeiture of all payments made. Changes requested more than 90 days before the customer's scheduled program will be allowed, subject to availability, with a \$750 change fee imposed. If we can reschedule your flight date with another participant, then you will receive funds paid by Participant as a refund, but your deposit will be forfeited.

### **PROGRAM CANCELLATION**

World Flyers reserves the right to cancel a Flight Expedition for any reason prior to departure. In that event, World Flyers will refund application and program fees paid by Participants. In the event of cancellation of a program and upon refund to Participants of all program fee payments, World Flyers shall be released from any further liability to Participants, including but not limited to liability for additional costs Participants may have incurred, pre-departure expenses, non-refundable advance purchase air tickets, lodging, equipment purchases and medical expenses.

### **OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Participants understand that no guarantees have been made with respect to the objectives of the program.

Participants acknowledge that they are advised to buy personal life, medical, accident, travel, baggage, cancellation, rescue, and other insurance that may pertain to their participation in the program. Participants understand that World Flyers provides them with no such insurance coverage.

The Flight Expeditions are designed to be completed within the stated amount of time; however, circumstances beyond our control could prevent you from completing the flight in the specified time. These circumstances may include, but are not limited to: adverse weather, equipment failure, illness, acts of terrorism and the participant's own limitations.

Completion of a Flight Expedition and the instruction received during the flight does not guarantee that my instructor(s) will endorse me for a written test or practical test. The decision to provide such endorsements is strictly at the discretion of my flight instructor(s).

**Model Release for Media:** I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless World Flyers, and any of its assigns or other delegated persons from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, which are in any way connected with the use of my image, words, voice, or likeness which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity, in any electronic, electromagnetic, digital, photographic, print, sound, or audio-visual format in regards to advertising, promotions, marketing, cybercasts, literature, newspaper/journal articles, documentary films and video, radio, recordings, websites, email, and/or any other use which World Flyers deems fit and/or reasonable

**Identification documents required and Foreign Students:** All students must provide a valid Passport. All flight crew members are responsible for obtaining the correct and current visa for travel, flight training and getting TSA approvals. World Flyers does not provide visa service to foreign students. There is a non-refundable foreign student application fee of \$1,500.00 for all students that are not US citizens.

**Non-competite Clause:** You agree not to engage in any similar world flight type of business for compensation for a period of seven (7) years from the completion date of your flight. You may fly for World Flyers as an instructor on other flights. This is on a first come first serve basic, and approval of World Flyers administrators.

**Not Included:** Meals, rental cars, taxis, laundry, tips, headsets, maps and charts, and any personal costs such as telephone calls, souvenirs, custom and visa fees, etc. Costs are based on a minimum of three paying flight crew members. If this minimum is not reached, then World Flyers reserves the right to cancel the Flight Expedition and to refund all moneys, or to request those already booked to pay a surcharge to cover increased costs. From time to time the authorities change certain flight rules, which can affect the cost of the Flight Expedition. Upon notification to the flight crew members of such changes, World Flyers reserves the right to charge any such increases

**Baggage:** Due to the limited baggage capacity of our aircraft, our Flight Expeditions are limited to two large suitcases not to exceed 60 pounds in weight nor 30"x22"x10" in dimension and one small piece of carry-on size luggage that does not exceed the dimensions of 17"x14"x6" (standard airline carry-on size). You can of course bring as much baggage you believe you need that can be kept at your lodging location in Colorado. World Flyers does not assume any responsibility for loss or damage to baggage or personal belongings.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** "World Flyers LLC" and/or its agents act solely as booking agents for the hotels, car rental, transportation companies, flight schools, flight instructors, testing centers and any other service in connection with the itineraries of individuals, pilot crews, and students in flight training. Reservations are made and accepted under the terms and conditions of each individual supplier. "World Flyers LLC" and its suppliers shall not be liable for any damage, loss, accident, injury, delay or irregularity, liability or expense to person or property due to an act or default by any hotel, carrier, flight school, instructor, or other company or person providing service included in the itinerary or training schedule. All lodging will be selected by World Flyers or one of its agents. If Participant wishes to have different lodging accommodations than those selected or provided by World Flyers, lodging cost will be paid by Participant and no refunds will be made.

In addition, "World Flyers LLC" and/or its agents accept no responsibility for any illness, theft, labor disputes, machinery breakdown, government constraints, acts of war or terrorism, weather conditions, acts of God, defect in any vehicle or transportation or for any misadventure or casualty or any other courses beyond their control. The responsibility of any airline used is solely set out in the passenger's contract as evidenced by the ticket. Airlines and other carriers are not responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not aboard their planes or conveyances. World Flyers does not make any refunds on airlines tickets or lodging bought by participant, even if your round-the-world flight is canceled for any reason.

**Privacy Agreement:** World Flyers LLC follows strict security standards and procedures to help prevent unauthorized access to personal information, aircraft and airports. Only properly authorized employees and/or agents of World Flyers may access information World Flyers collects from or about customers. Instructors of or used by World Flyers who have access to customer or consumer information may use it only for legitimate business purposes. Additionally, World Flyers safeguards customer information in accordance with data security regulations, including personal information received via the Internet. We may disclose information we collect about our customers to government, regulatory and legal authorities in response to a subpoena, to prevent acts of terrorism, or to comply with an inquiry by a government agency. We never give out customer contact information to anyone requesting references.

**Right to Refuse Service:** World Flyers Inc reserves the right to refuse service to anyone at anytime who is not a US Citizen or is found to be unsafe. I understand that I must furnish a valid Passport or a certified Birth Certificate and a current medical upon my arrival. If I do not have these documents with me upon my arrival, I understand that I will not be able to receive training and that no refunds will be made in any of the above cases.

**Disputes:** In the unlikely event there is any dispute between the customer and World Flyers that can not be resolved by both parties within 60 days, the parties will submit to mediation by a mediator chosen by both parties and, if not resolved by mediation, then by binding arbitration by one arbitrator chosen by the parties, or if no choice can be made, then by an arbitrator chosen by federal judge for the district of Colorado. All proceedings shall occur in Denver, Colorado, and Colorado law shall apply. The customer agrees to this exclusive jurisdiction and venue in Colorado for resolving all disputes.

# **FORM 4: Acknowledgement of Risk and Contract, Waiver, Release and Indemnification**

## **IMPORTANT: THIS IS A LEGAL DOCUMENT**

Please read and understand this document before signing. If you have any questions please consult us and/or your attorney. **Please review and sign with spouse.**

World Flyers Inc has taken care to assure that our Participants experience a rewarding Flight Expedition. We wish to inform our Participants that flying and foreign travel are not risk free. The same elements that contribute to the unique character and fun of exploring and flying on our Flight Expeditions, including our around the world flight expedition can cause loss or damage to equipment, injury, illness, or in extreme cases, trauma, or death. We do not want to heighten or reduce your enthusiasm for the experience, but we do want you to know in advance what to expect and to be informed of some of the possible risks. We ask that you read this release of liability, sign it, and return the original documents it to our office.

### **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK**

You, the Participant, need to understand that you are going to be entering an environment with significant hazard and risks, including those associated with living, flying, and traveling in foreign countries that may be politically unstable, worldwide dangers associated with the war on terrorism, and with the forces of nature. Below is a list of the possible hazards but not all of the hazards you may encounter.

Travel is by vehicle, animal, bus, and on foot. The travel in foreign countries includes automobile, taxi, truck, bus, train, aircraft, helicopter, animal, and other modes of transportation. Many times the risks associated with transportation can be as great as the flying risk itself. You assume the risk of all travel arranged by yourself or by World Flyers.

Meals in some countries are prepared over stoves and sometimes-open fires. Water often requires disinfecting before use. Hazards may include burns, fires, carbon monoxide poisoning, cuts, diarrhea and flu-like illness. All water should be treated before ingesting once you leave the United States.

Environmental risks include, insects, snakes, and predators including large animals, falling and rolling rock, lightning, flash floods, and unpredictable forces of nature, including weather that may change to extreme conditions without notice. Additional risks are frostbite, high altitude illness, sunburn, heatstroke, dehydration, and other mild or serious conditions.

Over-water flight and mountain flying are hazardous. The obvious accidents that occur in flying over water are loss of engine power and having to ditch in water. Flying over mountainous areas has its risk of unforeseen weather and equipment failures in rugged terrain.

Equipment may fail. The extreme conditions of the environment of flying around the world and the toll on aircrafts and aircraft equipment when used in conjunction can cause damage and the equipment could fail. This could happen in rugged and over the water which could result in serious injury or death.

Medical care, as you understand it, may not be available outside the United States. You may be hours or days travel by water, porter, animal or other non-vehicular transportation from any medical facility. The medical facility you may be treated in may not have the same standards as hospitals or doctor's offices in the United States. The medical

personnel you will be treated by may not have the same training as medical personnel in the U.S. You will be subject to bacteria, viruses and diseases, which are rare or unknown in the U.S. You will need to be vigilant in your normal daily habits such as eating, hand-washing and bodily functions in order to not introduce dangerous bacteria, virus and diseases into your system.

Decisions are made by the World Flyers instructor, staff and Participants on the round-the-world flight expedition based on a variety of perceptions and evaluations, which by their nature are imprecise and subject to errors in judgment. Participant understands and agrees to abide by these decisions. **However, the Participant must exercise their own ability and thought in keeping safe and secure, and is solely liable for their safety and that absent direction from World Flyers it is his or her decision to fly or to return home at any time.** Throughout the trip, Participant is responsible for his or her own safety and for the safety of other members of their flight expedition. Participant agrees to adhere to all decisions made by the employees, contractors, guides, instructors, owners and members of World Flyers staff or instructors at all times. Participant understands that those decisions may be based on many factors, including the overall safety of the flight team. Participant understands and agrees to those decisions, which are in fact the way most professionally conducted flight expeditions operate.

There is a high level of stress and anxiety while undertaking any flight expedition, including our Round the World Flight Expedition. In addition you may encounter or see sights, which may disturb you. It is also possible that some participants will suffer mental anguish or trauma from the experience or their injuries.

This list is not an exclusive or exhaustive list of possible risks, injuries, trauma, or accidents that may occur while flying around the world. Most of these injuries are rare and you are not likely to encounter them, however they have occurred and you need to know about them, as well as other possible injuries not mentioned above. Some injuries occur more often when the participants are using illegal drugs or alcohol or are not physically able to undertake the flight expedition, so the use of illegal drugs or alcohol will not be permitted on the trip while engaged in flying activities.

#### **CONTRACT, WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION**

I certify that my family, including minor children, spouse, representatives, heirs, assigns, subrogors and dependent parents, understands the risks of being a flight crew member on a round-the-world flight and the legal consequences of this document. I am fully capable of participating in the selected Flight Expedition. I state that I have read the above statement on some of the possible risks in flying and being a flight crew member on a Flight Expedition, and I voluntarily accept them. Therefore, I assume all risks in participating in this activity, including but not limited to those listed above, for myself and my family, including minor children, spouse and dependent parents, for bodily injury, death and loss of personal property and any expenses as a result of my negligence, negligence of my family, negligence of another participant or the negligence of World Flyers, its instructors, agents and employees. I also understand that World Flyers reserves the right to refuse continued participation in the flight expedition to any person it judges to be incapable of meeting the rigors and requirements of participation. I am in good physical condition and able to undertake this expedition.

I further agree to release, acquit and covenant not to sue World Flyers for any and all claims, causes of action or damages, or remedies in equity of whatever kind, including those alleging the negligence of World Flyers, other participants, my family, minor children, spouse, dependent parents, myself, or my heirs, against World Flyers arising out of participation in this flight expedition. In short, I cannot sue World Flyers and if I do, I

cannot collect any money and that I will pay any and all legal expenses including my legal expenses and those of World Flyers.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless World Flyers from all claims, damages, losses, injuries and expenses arising out of or resulting from my family's or my participation in these activities. This indemnification extends to the members of my immediate family, minor children, and spouse and dependent parents in my household. In consideration of my being able to participate in the activity I agree to indemnify and hold harmless World Flyers for any costs associated with my death or with any injury I may receive, or transportation not covered in the itinerary due to my death or injury or early departure.

I hereby authorize any medical treatment or rescue deemed to be necessary I hereby give permission for transportation to any medical facility or hospital and I authorize for any qualified instructor, guide or medical personnel to render necessary emergency medical care for my family or myself. I hereby authorize the release of any medical information in the possession of World Flyers to any medical facility, hospital, ambulance, first aid provider, first aid service, doctor, nurse or other such person rendering care on my behalf. I hereby waive any action or claim against World Flyers or any health care provider, hospital, doctor, nurse or first aid provider for the release of this medical information.

I agree that Colorado law shall be applied in any legal action involving the interpretation, validity and/or enforceability of this agreement or any disagreement or legal action between the parties, and that any legal action, lawsuits or arbitration resulting from my participation in this activity shall be brought only in Chaffee County, Colorado.

Should a court of competent jurisdiction declare any part of this agreement unenforceable, the remaining parts or paragraphs shall remain in full force and effect. A copy of this release can be used as if it were an original. The terms of this agreement shall continue and be in effect after the Flight Expedition.

As liquidated damages, I hereby agree that if World Flyers is forced to defend any action, lawsuit or litigation by myself, my executors, or my heirs, on my family's or my behalf, my heirs or executors and I agree to pay World Flyers's costs and attorney fees if they successfully defend such action, lawsuit or litigation.

This flight expedition involves high altitude flight and possible cold temperatures, along with the dangers from altitude sickness, accidents, and illness in a remote area. Professional medical help may be days away. All participants must be in satisfactory physical condition and be mentally stable. In addition, we recommend that participants carry certain prescription drugs with themselves in their personal medical kit. Possible drugs to consider may include the following, and others:

- 1) Antibiotic for upper respiratory problems;
- 2) Antibiotic for GI problems;
- 3) Sleeping pills for jet lag;
- 4) Tylenol 3 or similar for severe headaches;
- 5) Malaria Chemoprophylaxis, if needed based on travel plans;
- 6) Asthma medication, if any history.

Please assist your patient in obtaining these or other drugs that you would advise for extended travel in the third world away from western style medical care.
